**Fire Department/First Response:
911 or 248-2300**

Dialing 911 will get you emergency dispatch and they will dispatch the local responders. The local ambulance is the Woonsocket Ambulance which is also manned by volunteers. In a situation where time is of the utmost importance if you call 911 you may want to ask for the Mitchell Ambulance. Sometimes they are just as quick as Woonsocket as they don't have to wait for volunteers to arrive at the station – especially if you are south of Letcher. 248-2300 rings the fire bar and notifies our volunteers without going thru the 911 dispatch.
